Fall Trap League Starts 8/23



The Fall 2018 Trap League will start on Thursday, August 23, 2018, at 5:30 PM. To save time on the 23rd, you are invited and encouraged to register your team early, whether your team will be returning or new to the league. After you have submitted your team

registration, you will be able to pay your league fees at the counter starting on Saturday, 8/18. Individuals who would like to join and be assigned to a team are also invited to register.

To register your team - please have one member of your team download and complete the Excel registration form with your team's name and captain, then by post each member's name and email address. Save the Excel file as your team's name, then email the file to SCSCTrap@gmail.com. ***If your team will be returning unchanged from the Spring 2018 league, return the spreadsheet with the team's name and indicate unchanged or list only the posts that will be different.***

To register your team if email unable: complete and leave to my attention the registration form at the club counter including your team's name, the captain and his phone number, then by post each member's name and email address. Print clearly. Registration forms will be available at the counter.

To register as an individual – send your name, email address and phone number to SCSCTrap@gmail.com or leave the information at the counter to my attention

Volunteers – We need several volunteers each week to help run the league and keep the teams flowing smoothly. Let me know if you would like to help. Work hours are available for helping with the league.

See the **Rules for the Fall 2018 Trap League**. Note especially that for shooting and trap members, your club membership must be current through October 23, 2018, before you will be allowed to participate. New, or lapsed more than 90 days, shooting and trap members must complete the required safety course before they will be able to participate in the league. Check with membership for the days and times that this course will be available.

Fall 2018 Trap League Rules

1. Schedule:
 - a. The trap league will shoot on 8 Thursday evenings, 5:30 – 9:59 PM, from August 23 thru October 11. All shooting at the club must stop before 10:00 PM. The last day to make up any missed rounds will be Tuesday, October 23.
 - b. The league final event and awards presentation will be on Thursday, October 25, starting at 6:00 PM
2. Team Competition - each team member will shoot:
 - a. Singles – 25 rounds from the 16 yard line
 - b. Handicap – 25 rounds from the yard line equivalent to the team average score earned during that evening's singles competition, but not less than 18 yards.
 - c. Team captains are expected to verify all scores and indicate their approval by signing score sheets before they are submitted.
3. Makeup rounds:
 - a. Team missed rounds may be made up anytime during the regular hours that the club is open and staffed before the end of shooting on October 23 – makeup score sheets must include the team's name, the week being made up, and include the squad leader's signature. No more than 3 team makeup rounds will be allowed to qualify for league end Lewis prizes unless preapproved by the league chair.
 - b. Individual missed rounds may be made up anytime during the regular hours that the club is open and staffed. Makeup score sheets must include the individual's and the team's name as well as the week being made up. Handicap yardage will be from the yard line equivalent to the team average score earned during that evening's singles competition.
No more than three (3) individual makeup rounds will be allowed to qualify for the team's high gun award.
4. Shooting ahead – shooting ahead of the current date will be allowed twice during the 8 week league
5. Qualification – Teams must have attempted 2,000 targets, and individuals 400, to qualify for league end prizes.
6. The league cost will be \$125.00 (\$15.00 per night), plus an additional \$5.00 league fee payable the first night. There will be a separate \$1.00 individual high gun purse available each league night. Those paying by credit card are encouraged to pay the full \$130.
7. Lewis prizes will be awarded to individuals weekly for scores shot during the prior Thursday evening competition. Made up rounds will not qualify for individual Lewis prizes.
8. League high gun and team awards will be presented at the final event on October 25.
9. League participation requirements – The trap league is open to all full members, shooting members, and trap members of the St Charles Sportsmen's Club. For shooting and trap members, your membership must be current through October 25, 2018, to be eligible to compete.
10. League management reserves the right to disqualify anyone for unruly or unsafe behavior.
